Scholarship Rules and Application

The Rules

1. All entries must be postmarked by **April 30**. This is an extended deadline.
2. Applicant must maintain a “C” grade point average.
3. Use standard English language in a 300-word essay entitled, “What it means to be a Catholic woman in the world today” typed and double-spaced on a standard 8.5” x 11” page.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation – one letter each from your school counselor, pastor, youth minister, or a non-family member.
5. The scholarship will be awarded the summer before the applicant enters her first year of college/university.
6. This is a four-year renewable scholarship. The scholarship will be terminated if the awardee leaves college/university before the completion of four years.
7. In September and January, a \$500 scholarship payment will be sent to the college/university upon receipt of the previous term’s transcript.
